## Internet E-Safety - Parents Awareness Talk 3:30pm Tuesday 9th February 2016 in Worsley Mesnes School Hall



We have invited Ian Risdale who is an E Safety expert to Worsley Mesnes.

He will share his vast knowledge and show short clips about how children can use the internet safely. He will also be available to answer questions and lead discussion with parents. Teachers will provide after school activities in a classroom for the children of parents who wish to attend.

The internet provides many fantastic opportunities but with these opportunities the need to be safe becomes more important all the time.

E- safety is part of the ICT lessons in school but this will give parents chance to talk to an expert.

If you have any concerns about your children's online activities and especially their safety (which is probably all of us) or just want more information, please come to this meeting. Ian will also work with Year 5 and Year 6 children in the afternoon.
