Good Diabetes Care in School Award



Recently in the news there has been concern about the pollution produced by parked cars with their engines running especially around schools.

Put a stop to idling engines

Running your engine unnecessarily while your vehicle is stationary pollutes the environment. It's also against the law on a public highway.

What are the problems?

An idling engine can produce up to twice as many exhaust emissions as an engine in motion. Exhaust emissions contain a range of air pollutants such as carbon monoxide, nitrogen dioxide, and particulate matter. These can affect the quality of the air **we all breathe and the surrounding environment.**
